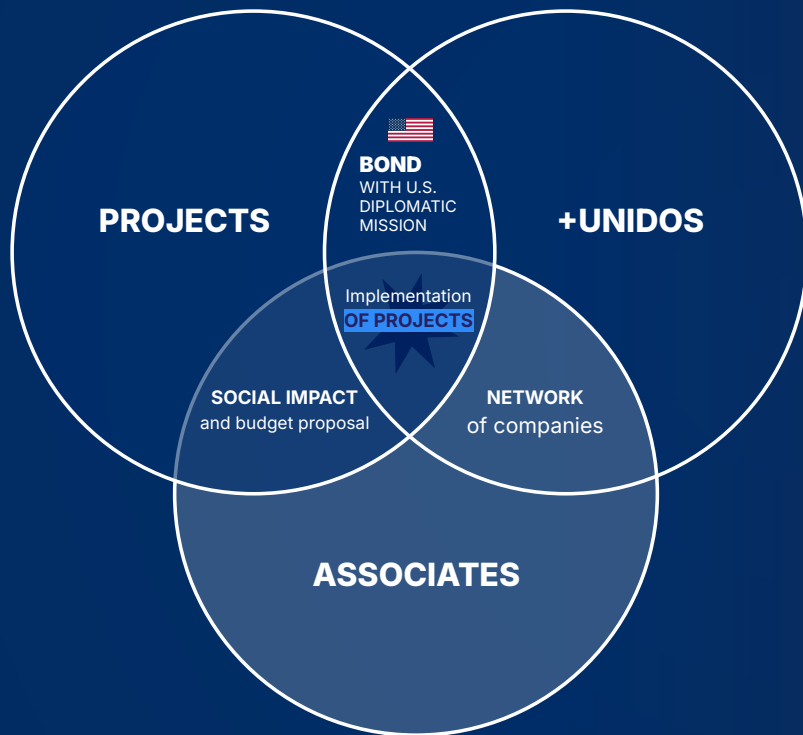

THE SIX PILLARS OF +UNIDOS METHODOLOGY

#1 PARTICIPANT IN THE CENTER

The active listening and continued community participation guarantee adherence to the territory and a higher sustainability impact.

#2 FOCUS ON THE LEARNING PROCESS

Active learning, focusing on developing future competencies. This leads to more employability and income generation.

#3 GOVERNANCE AND COOPERATION

Multisectoral articulation: adaptive governance and use of efficient resources, promoting alignment between social impact and institutional strategy.

#4 MONITORING AND EVALUATION

Clear KPIs, continue monitoring, impact evaluation based on evidence, and experience with strict methodologies as control groups (RCT).

#5 SCALABILITY AND INNOVATION

Methodologies that are replicable and adaptable to different contexts, aligning innovation, scale, and valorization of local diversity.

#6 TRANSPARENCY AND COMPLIANCE

Auditable Income Statement, institutional compliance, and reports aligned with the partners' necessities.

IMPACT

Our programs could work as independent CSOs (Civil Society Organizations). Combined in one structure, the programs become stronger due to **Grupo +Unidos's** methodology and governance.

The program *Rede Amazônia + Conectada* provided internet access and training programs to **more than 600 families**

+More than 570 teenagers and young people graduated in social entrepreneurship. They also gained experience in diplomacy and international affairs

Four innovation centers were constructed with our partners' help in the states of São Paulo and Minas Gerais. The centers benefit **more than 2 million students** with curriculum updates, training, and resources for public schools

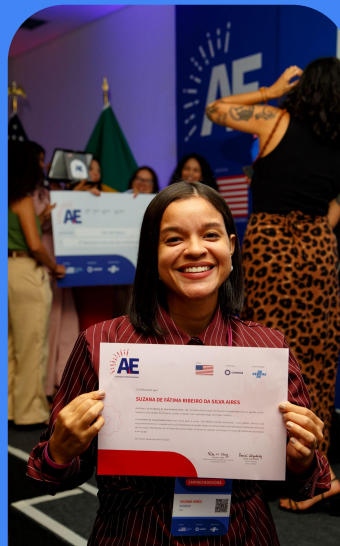

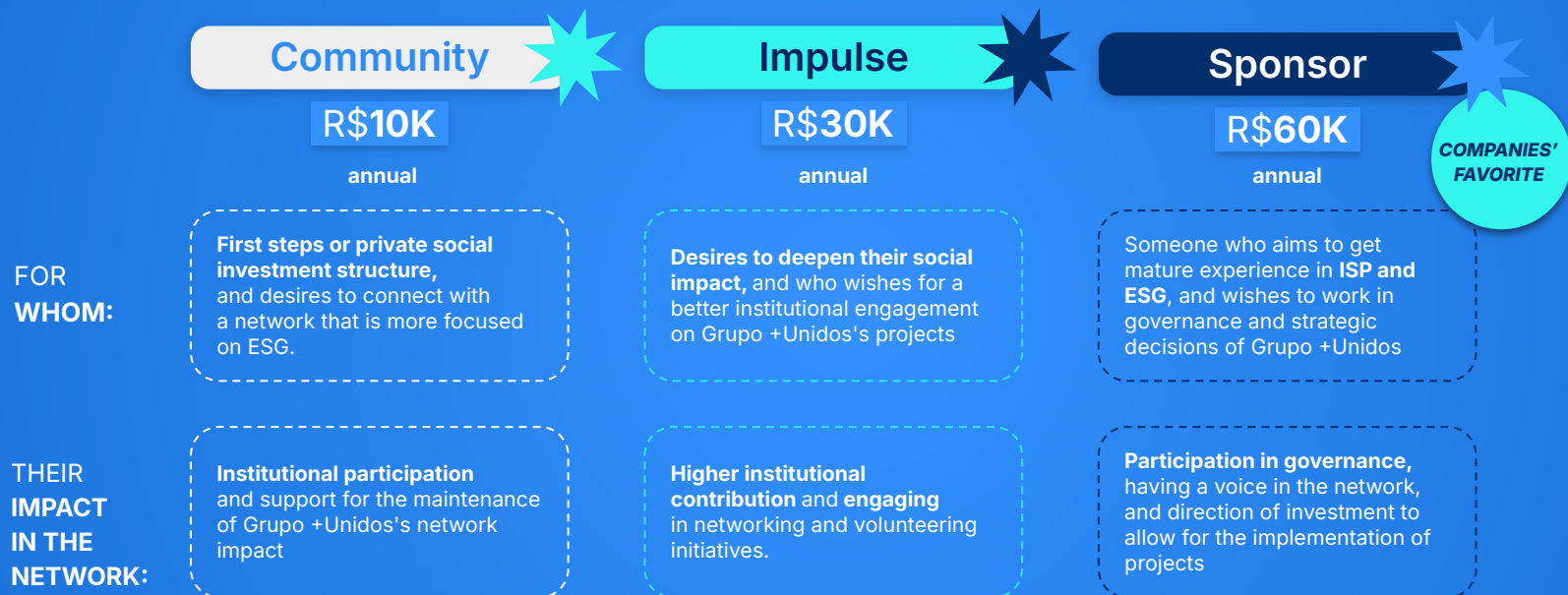

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Transformando vidas com a conectividade

A Rede Amazônia +Conectada é uma iniciativa do Grupo +Unidos, organização da sociedade civil que atua como plataforma de empresas, organizações do terceiro setor e investidores sociais privados para o desenvolvimento social sustentável do Brasil.

A iniciativa vai além da simples conexão de pontos, buscando a inclusão digital e a capacitação das comunidades locais para fortalecer o desenvolvimento econômico e social.

Para a produção do documento, foram consultados especialistas em tecnologia, economia e desenvolvimento social.

Você sabia?

A Amazônia Legal abriga mais de 28 milhões de pessoas, mas quase metade ainda vive com acesso precário ou inexistente à internet. Das áreas rurais, apenas 25,1% da população tem cobertura 4G/LTE, e a banda larga fixa chega a pouco mais da metade dos domicílios — índices muito abaixo de outros estados.

Essa exclusão digital limita o acesso a serviços essenciais, como saúde e educação, e dificulta a geração de renda. É preciso investir mais em infraestrutura e capacitação para reduzir a desigualdade.
